

SCHOOL DANCES REGULATIONS

1. All students will be required to use the passive alcohol-screening (PAS) device as a condition for participation in the dance.
2. No one will be allowed to enter a dance an hour after the official start of the dance. Students cannot leave the dance until one half hour from the scheduled end time.
3. Students leaving a dance may not return.
4. Middle school students may not attend high school dances. Guests older than 20 years of age may not attend.
5. All dances, other than proms and formals, will end no later than 10:30 P.M.
6. The facility must be cleaned up immediately following dances except for proms and formals.
7. All school rules apply during school dances.
8. Police supervision will be required and paid for by the organization sponsoring the dance.
9. Any student wishing to bring a student guest must present confirmation of the guest's good character and discipline from the attending high school or alma mater as well as emergency contact information such as parents' cell phone numbers to the administrators prior to the dance and a photocopy of the guest's photo ID. (Forms are available in the office. Only one guest per SHS student is allowed.) Guests are required to show a photo ID before entering the dance.
10. There will be a minimum of six chaperones at all dances.
11. Students must dress appropriately. (See Dress Code, p. 2-12 and 2-13.)
12. The sponsoring organization must keep a ticket list to be checked as students present their tickets at the door. **No tickets will be sold at the door.**
13. The student is responsible for presenting his/her ticket. No one will be admitted without a ticket.
14. A student must be in school from 7:30 A.M. until 11:44 A.M. to be eligible to attend a dance that evening. (In the case of a Saturday dance, the student must be in school from 7:30 A.M. until 11:44 A.M. the Friday before the dance).
15. Students who owe any accountabilities (financial and/or discipline) may not purchase tickets and/or attend any school dances or formal social functions.
16. **Prom Advisory:** The location of proms and formals not held on school grounds must be approved by the school administration. Confirmation of student guest's good character and discipline must be presented to the advisor during the two (2) weeks prior to the sale of prom tickets. **Prior to approval of guests, students are advised to refrain from monetary commitments related to the prom.**
