

SENIOR PRIVILEGE

- Privilege:**
1. To allow seniors who have a study either first or last block of the day to sign in late or leave early.
 2. Any other privilege specified by the administration for seniors.

Rationale: Senior year should become a transition to college/the world of work. One of the key elements of success during the first semester of anyone's college experience or first experience on the job is exercising responsibility. By allowing seniors these privileges, they will learn to be more responsible for their actions and for their use of time prior to the first semester of their freshman year in college.

Eligibility Criteria: In order to be eligible for this senior privilege, the following conditions must be met:

1. Credit status consistent with a June 2010 graduation.
2. A minimum grade of **C-** in every class. (No **D**'s or **F**'s).
3. Per quarter, no more than:
 - 0 unexcused absences
 - 2 unexcused tardies to school
 - 2 tardies to class
 - 0 infractions related to Student I.D. Cards (See Student Agenda/Planner p.7.)
 - 0 office detentions
 - 0 suspensions
4. Parental permission: parent/guardian sign off

In order to maintain eligibility, the conditioning delineated above must be maintained with the provision that **a senior must not be late to school or Home Base when he/she has a study during Block A only.**

***Students enrolled in LAC, VHS, or Independent Study are not allowed to sign out under senior privilege as credit is received for these courses.**

Remember, this is a privilege, so that if **all** of the aforementioned conditions are not maintained, the privilege will be revoked.

A list of eligible seniors will be made available to the entire staff. Eligibility will be reviewed at Progress Reports and Grade Reporting at the end of each quarter.

LOSS OF PRIVILEGES WILL ALSO BE ISSUED FOR:

Failure to sign in or out in the office for senior release or being disrespectful to office personnel.

1st offense – two weeks

2nd offense – marking period

IF ANY VIOLATION OCCURS WITHIN ONE MONTH OF THE CLOSE OF THE MARKING PERIOD, LOSS OF PRIVILEGE WILL CARRY INTO THE NEXT MARKING PERIOD.
